thing you regret not doing freshman year and senior year?

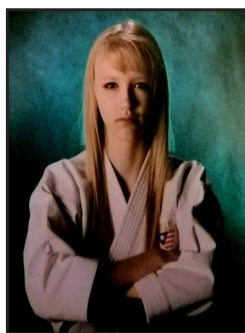

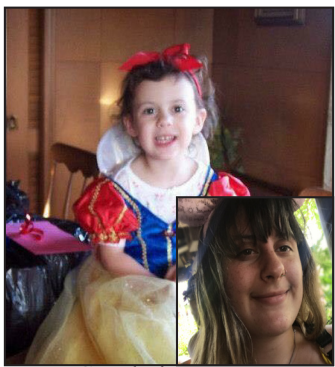

I was nervous and scared my first day; for my last day I'm feeling kind of bittersweet, I'm more happy that it'll be over though.



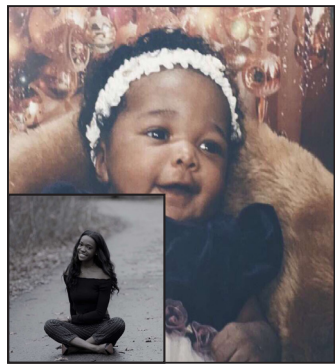

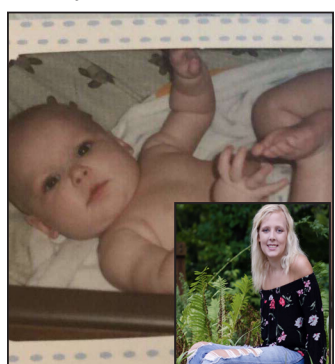

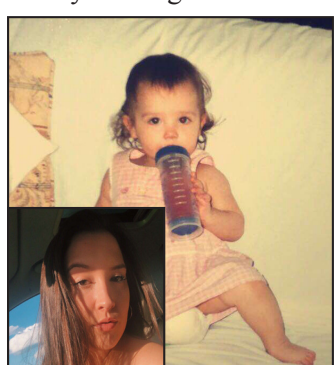

2016 vs 2019 Trends



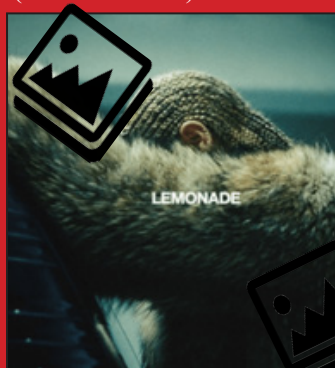
